

# CYJ - REIMAGINING JUSTICE WITH CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE

## PHASE 1 DISCOVERY & DEFINE (no cost)

### DISCOVER

Info gathering - questionnaires & workshops (children/YP/families/staff/partners)

CYJ will work with your workshop facilitator to identify local context and consultation workshop requirements

CYJ will also support you to seek views and perspectives of children, young people and their families.

### DEFINE

Findings from information gathering activities inform consultation workshop to define problem while aligning with aims, objective and wider policy/practice/legislation

Consultation workshop identifies focus for greatest potential to achieve and improve and if there is need for new service or build on what exists

CYJ will take notes summarising what a well-designed approach may look like based on your aims, objectives and context which can then be kept as a record/used to outline areas of achievement and improvement.

### END of PHASE 1 & OPTIONS

CYJ provides brief record reflecting potential actions to aid thinking and build evidence for what you might do next. Also, how to include service-users going forward.

Whether to progress to Phase 2 - Develop & Deliver?

Consider the preparedness of your organisation should you wish to progress to Phase 2 (costed service).

Whether this would be meaningful or what is needed to progress?

## PHASE 2 DEVELOP & DELIVER (costed)

### DEVELOP

Design Brief using PHASE 1

Improvement group created  
CYJ mentor identified, who records iterative process and aids analysis and refinement of ideas; support from CYJ participation team

Ideate

Test, evaluate and validate ideas with children/YP/families/ staff/partners)

Use feedback for refinement and identifying what will be scaled up and implemented.

### DELIVER

CYJ will support you to do final testing, launching the new processes/service  
Feedback loops for evaluation (children/YP/parents/ staff/partners)

CYJ supports staff to understand and implement changes  
CYJ provide relevant training and info on wider learning opportunities

Final improvement session to analyse process and learning  
CYJ provide a brief final report

Sharing learning.

## PHASE 3 EVALUATION (costed)

Costed and provided by the CYJ research team. A full or part service evaluation over a 1-3 year period. The focus and scale of this evaluation would be led by you and could include one or more of the following:

- Documenting and describing the implementation and delivery of the service
- Understanding the experience of the service by gathering feedback from service users and staff
- Assessing the effectiveness of the service by analysing routinely collected service data or other data gathering to identify impact and outcomes.
- Other evaluation activity as agreed
- A final evaluation report would be produced
